



Available options to pay Indian Bank Credit Card bills

<p>Through Indian Bank Mobile Banking App i.e. Ind SMART App</p> 	<p>You can pay the Credit Card dues through Ind SMART App, following the steps outlined below-</p> <p>Process-1</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login in Ind Smart App 2. Select Credit Card 3. Enter Amount to Pay 4. Click on Pay <p>Process-2</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login to Ind Smart App 2. Bill Payments 3. Pay to New Billers 4. Select Biller Category as "Credit Card" 5. Select Biller as "Indian Bank Credit Card" 6. Enter Registered Mobile Number in Credit Card 7. Last 4 digits of Credit Card Number 8. Click on Verify 9. Click Continue 10. Select the Pay By Account 11. Continue and confirm the details and payment will be validated with TPIN and OTP
<p>Through Indian Bank Net Banking Platform</p> 	<p>You can pay your Credit Card dues through Indian Bank Net Banking following the steps outlined below:</p> <p>Process:-1</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to Indian Bank Net Banking. 2. Navigate to "Manage Beneficiary" and select "IB Credit Card." <p>After successfully adding the card as a beneficiary, payments can be made as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log in to Indian Bank Net Banking. 2. Go to "Fund Transfer" and select "Credit Card Pay" 3. In the "From Account" section, mention the account from which the transfer will be made. 4. In the "To Account" section, select the beneficiary card details from the dropdown menu. 5. Enter the amount to be paid and click on "Proceed." 6. Validate the payment through TPIN. <p>Process:-2</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Login to Indian Bank Net Banking 2. Bill Payments/Recharge 3. Pay to New Billers 4. Select Category as "Credit Card"

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Select Biller as "Indian Bank Credit Card" 6. Enter Registered Mobile Number in Credit Card 7. Last 4 digits of Credit Card Number 8. Click on Submit 9. Select the Account no. 10. Enter Transaction Password and submit to pay.

Through Credit Card Bill Payment Apps	<p>You can Pay your due can be done through any of the reputed Bill Payment Apps like BHIM/Gpay/Phone Pe/Paytm/CRED etc. following the steps outlined below</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Installing the App from Play Store/App Store 2. Recharge & Bill Payment (nomenclature of the option may vary slightly based on the platform) 3. Select Credit Card 4. Add the Card using registered mobile no or Last four digit of the card 5. Fetch the Bill details 6. Do the payment. 				
Through Auto Debit Facility	You can either visit Indian Bank branch and submit the application in person, or you can send the request for auto-debit directly to the Credit Card Centre's email ID: creditcard@indianbank.co.in, using your registered email ID. This request to set up the auto-debit facility to be provided either for Full Due or Minimum Due amount of monthly Billed Statement from linked Indian Bank SB/CA.
